Specifics of the scholarship are listed below:

1. The scholarship will be awarded annually.
2. Applicant must be a member of the Wisconsin Junior Guernsey Breeders Association.
3. Applicant must have graduated from high school.
4. Applicant must be a student at a post high school college, vocational, trade school or short course.
5. Application must be received at the WGBA office by **February 10, 2016**.
6. The amount of the award to be equal to the approximate interest on the invested money, with a minimum scholarship of \$100 each year, (currently \$500).
7. If there are no applications in a year, the minimum amount of the award will accumulate to the following year.
